The Hohner Clavinet provides a completely new sound and appearance for today's professional musician.

An electronic version of the Clavichord, it can sound like an electric guitar, harp, spinet, or harpsichord. Its sound is created by strings struck directly by piano keys. The mechanical vibrations of the strings are transformed into electronic vibrations and fed through an amplifier.

Unlike other electro-mechanical keyboard instruments, the Clavinet has a dynamic keyboard; volume is influenced by how hard you hit the keys—as on a piano. This allows you to freely express musical shadings from soft to loud. A light touch insures a light response, a heavier touch gives you a more percussive attack.

The Clavinet is completely portable, is its own carrying case, and has easily removable legs that fit into a hidden compartment underneath the keyboard lid.
